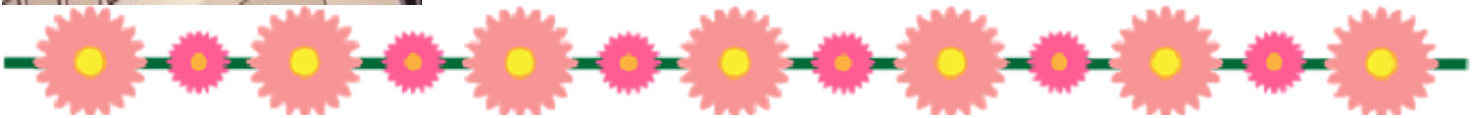


**FROM THE DESK OF YOUR CITY TREASURER, Dawn Sawicki-Franz**

Your Imlay City Police Department is hard at work both in the field and in the classroom. Sergeant Leathers completed “First line Supervision-Transition to Administration” this month, a two-day course designed for new leaders and administrators. Also this month, Sergeant Leathers will be attending “Achieving Supervisory Excellence” leadership training for police executives. (SRO) Officer Cory Martin and Officer Emily Koning completed “Managing the Property and Evidence Room”- This two-day course aimed at organizational compliance with State and Federal guidelines when handling and managing the police property room. The Imlay City police Department hosted this training at the Eastern Michigan Fairgrounds and found in-person learning is gaining momentum again because 3 officers came from Michigan’s Upper Peninsula and one officer came from northwest Indiana along with other officers throughout the state to take this training.

A Private donor paid in full A Train the Trainer seat in the next *ALICE* school safety training for two Imlay City Officer’s to attend training March 29-30<sup>th</sup>. Both Officers will then be able to train the Imlay City School faculty and staff. This grant is valued at nearly \$1,498.00 plus hotel accommodations for two officers to take the training. The Imlay City Police Department has numerous other trainings scheduled throughout the year.
