PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED FY2022-2023 BUDGET

The City of Imlay City is giving public notice of the availability of the FY 2022-23 budget proposal as submitted by the City Manager to the City Commission pursuant to the Imlay City Charter Chapter 8, General Finance. Copies of the budget proposal are available at City Hall, 150 N Main Street, Imlay City, Michigan 48444 from Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00AM and 4:30PM.

A public hearing on the FY 2022-2023 budget proposal will be held at City Hall on Tuesday, May 03, 2022 at 7:00PM or as soon thereafter as may be heard. The proposed property tax millage rates to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing.

The estimated 17.3890 mills are levied on the taxable valuation for the purpose of meeting operating requirements of the General Fund, 2.4531 mills levied for road and sidewalks, 1.7900 mills levied for the fire hall and 1.5000 mills are levied on the taxable valuation for the purpose of drains for the fiscal year of 2022-2023.
