### Did You Know?

The average household has about 5 flushes a day. An older toilet uses 7 gallons per flush, a newer one could be as low as 1.6 gallons per flush. If it is 7 gallons that is 12,775 gallons per year on flushes. At 67% that would eliminate 8,559 gallons of water usage per year in your household.

### FROM THE DESK OF ED PRIEHS, DPW SUPERINTENDENT

Expectations are that the toilet will flush 24 hours a day 365 days a year and this can be accomplished, but sewers are designed to dispose of only very specific things including: water, toilet paper, and human waste. The biggest issue affecting sewers locally is grease. A by-product of cooking, grease comes from meat fats, lard, oil, shortening, butter, margarine, food scraps, baking goods, sauces, and dairy products. When washed down the sink, grease sticks to the inside of sewer pipes (both in the property's sewer line and the City's main). Over time, it can build up and block the entire pipe and the results can be raw sewage overflowing in your home, your neighbor's home or business, and many other issues including an increase in operation and maintenance costs for the sewer department.
